

Designed, Pieced and Quilted by Jennifer Fulton Inquiring Quilter

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MATERIALS:

[1] Tiles Navy Panel
1/4 yard Ohio
7/8 yard Flags Blue
1-1/2 yards Words Navy
5/8 yard Words Ivory
3-1/4 yards your choice of fabric for Backing

BEFORE SEWING, READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS. ALL SEAMS ARE 1/4" UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED. LABELS THE CUTS AS YOU GO. WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC; LOF = LENGTH OF FABRIC; RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER; HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE; QST = QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLE

CUTTING:

From Tiles Navy Panel:

Center and trim [15] — $6^{\prime\prime} \times$ 5-1/2" rectangles, motifs of your choosing

From Ohio Fabric:

Cut [2] - 3-1/2" \times WOF strips Subut [15] - 3-1/2" squares

From Flags Blue Fabric:

Cut [2] $- 4-1/2'' \times$ WOF strips Subut [15] - 4-1/2'' squares Cut [5] $- 3-1/2'' \times$ WOF strips Subut [60] - 3-1/2'' squares

From Words Navy Fabric:

- Cut [2] $4-1/2'' \times$ WOF strips Subut [15] - 4-1/2'' squares
- Cut [8] $-2-1/2'' \times WOF$ strips Subut [30] $-2-1/2'' \times 9-1/2''$ rectangles
- Cut $[5] 2 \cdot 1/2'' \times WOF$ strips for binding
- Cut [5] $-2-1/4'' \times WOF$ strips Subut [30] $-2-1/4'' \times 5-1/2''$ rectangles

From Words Ivory Fabric:

Cut [4] - 4-1/2" \times WOF strips Subut [30] - 4-1/2" squares

BLOCK ASSEMBLY: HST

- Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of [1] — Words Ivory 4-1/2" square.
- 2. Place Words Ivory square on top of [1] Words Navy 4-1/2" square.
- Sew 1/4" away from each side of the line. Cut on the line to make [2] HSTs.



- 4. Press to the dark. Do not trim. Repeat to make [30] Ivory/Navy HSTs.
- 5. Following the same procedure, make [30] Ivory/Flags HSTs.

QST

- Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner (across the seam) on the back of [1] lvory/ Flags HST.
- 2. Place Ivory/Flags HST on top of [1] Ivory/ Navy HST. Seams will nest.



3. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the line. Cut on the line to make [2] QSTs. Press. Trim to 3-1/2". Repeat to make [60] QSTs.



Block A

- 1. Arrange [4] Flags Blue 3-1/2" squares, [4] QSTs and [1] Ohio 3-1/2" squares as shown.
- 2. Sew each row pressing away from QSTs.
- 3. Sew the rows together. Trim to 9-1/2". Repeat to make [15] Block As.





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Block B

- 1. Sew [1] Words Navy 2-1/4" \times 5-1/2" rectangle to either side of [1] Tiles Navy 5-1/2" \times 6" rectangle.
- 2. Sew [1] Words Navy $2-1/2'' \times 9-1/2''$ rectangle to the top and bottom of this unit. Trim to 9-1/2''. Repeat to make [15] Block Bs.




QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:

- 1. Sew Block As and Block Bs as shown.
- 2. Sew each row, then sew the rows together to create Quilt Top.

FINISHING:

- 1. Layer top with batting and backing.
- 2. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Bind using Words Navy 2-1/2" strips.
- 4. Label and Enjoy!
