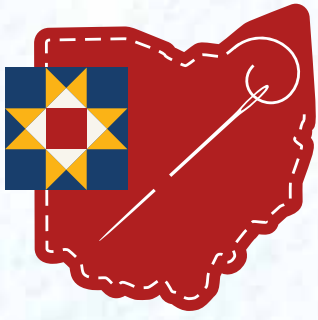

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

O H Block

1. Sew [1] Ohio Words 2-1/2" × 4-1/2" rectangle **(S)** in between [2] Ohio Words Multi 1-1/2" × 4-1/2" rectangles **(BB)**.



2. Sew [1] square **(F)** on the diagonal from lower left to upper right onto the upper left corner of [1] **(BB)**. Sew [1] square **(F)** on the diagonal of the right top corner of the **(BB)** from upper left to lower right. Make [2].



3. Sew units from Step 2 to the top and bottom of the unit from Step 1.



4. Sew [1] **(K)** to the left of the unit from Step 3.
5. Sew [1] **(Y)** below this unit.



6. Sew [1] rectangle **(AA1)** in between [2] rectangles **(R)** vertically.



7. Sew [1] rectangle **(CC1)** on right and left sides of the unit from Step 6.



8. Sew [1] rectangle **(T)** to the right of the unit from Step 7.
9. Sew [1] rectangle **(Z)** above this unit.



10. Sew unit from Step 5 to the left side of the unit from Step 9.



I O Block

1. Sew [1] rectangle **(BB)** in between [2] rectangles **(J)**.



2. Sew [1] rectangle **(AA)** to the top and the bottom of the unit from Step 2.



3. Sew [1] rectangle **(K)** to the left of unit from Step 2.
4. Sew [1] rectangle **(J)** to the top of the unit from Step 3.
5. Sew [1] rectangle **(X)** below the unit from Step 4.



6. Sew [1] rectangle **(S)** in between [2] rectangles **(BB1)**.



7. Sew [1] square **(F)** on the diagonal from lower left to upper right onto the upper left corner of [1] **(BB1)**. Sew [1] square **(F)** on the diagonal of the right top corner of the **(BB1)** from upper left to lower right. Make [2].



8. Sew units from Step 7 above and below unit from Step 6.



9. Sew [1] rectangle **(K)** to the right of the unit from Step 8.

10. Sew [1] rectangle **(W)** above this unit.



11. Sew [1] square **(A)** diagonally from lower left to upper right on [1] end of rectangle **(CC3)**.



12. Sew [1] rectangle **(O)** to the left of the unit from Step 11.

13. Sew [1] rectangle **(U)** to the right of the unit from Step 12.



14. Sew unit from Step 13 above the unit from Step 10.



15. Sew unit from Step 5 to the left of the unit from Step 14



Carnation Block:

Section 1

1. Sew [1] square **(A)** to the top end of [1] rectangle **(BB2)**. Make [2].



2. Sew [1] rectangle **(FF2)** in between the [2] units from Step 1.



3. Sew [1] rectangle **(CC2)** in between [2] rectangles **(C)**.



4. Sew unit from Step 3 on top of unit from Step 2. See Figure 1A.

5. Sew [1] rectangle **(E)** on top of unit from Step 4. See Figure 1B.

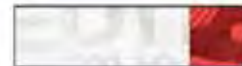

6. Sew [1] rectangle **(D)** to the right side of the unit from Step 5.



7. Sew [1] square **(AA2)** to one end of [1] **(C)**.



8. Sew [1] square **(Q)** above the unit from Step 7 as shown.



- Sew unit from Step 8 to the left of the unit from Step 6. Section measures 3" × 8-1/2".



Section 2

- Sew [1] rectangle (**BB4**) in between [2] squares (**AA2**). See Figure 1A.
- Sew [1] rectangle (**CC4**) below the unit from Step 1. See Figure 1B.

- Sew [1] rectangle (**BB2**) and [1] square (**AA4**) together. Make [2]. See Figure 3A.
- Sew units Step 3 to the right and left sides of the unit from Step 2. See Figure 3B.

- Sew [1] rectangle (**AA5**) in between [2] squares (**AA4**).



- Sew [1] square (**AA3**) on the diagonal from lower left to upper right on the right corner of [1] (**BB5**). Sew [1] (**AA3**) on the diagonal from upper left to lower right on the left corner of (**BB5**). See Figure 4A

- Sew unit from Step 5 to the top of unit from Step 6. See Figure 4B.

- Sew [1] rectangle (**BB2**) to the right and left sides of unit from Step 7.



- Sew unit from Step 4 above unit from Step 8.



- Sew [1] rectangle (**EE2**) to the left of the unit from Step 9.

- Sew [1] rectangle (**DD2**) to the right of the unit from Step 10.



- Sew the following pieces into a column from top to bottom: square (**AA2**), square (**A**), rectangle (**BB2**), and square (**A**). Make [2].



- Sew the first unit from Step 12 to the right of the unit from Step 10. Sew the second unit from Step 12 in a reversed position on the left side.



- Sew [1] rectangle (**I**) to the left of the unit from Step 13. Section measures 3" × 8-1/2".



Section 3

- Sew [1] square (**AA3**) diagonally from lower right to upper left on one end of [1] rectangle (**B**). See Figure 5A.
- Sew [1] rectangle (**BB2**) to the end of the unit from the previous step. See Figure 5B.

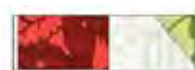

3. Sew [1] rectangle **(H)** below the unit from Step 2. See Figure 6A.
4. Sew [1] rectangle **(N)** to the left of the unit from Step 3. See Figure 6B.

5. Sew [1] square **(AA3)** diagonally from lower left to upper right on [1] end of [1] rectangle (B). Figure 7A.
6. Sew [1] rectangle **(AA2)** to the end of the unit from Step 5. Figure 7B.

7. Sew [1] rectangle **(B)** to the end of the unit from Step 6. See Figure 8A.
8. Sew [1] rectangle **(I)** below the unit from Step 7. See Figure 8B.

9. Sew [1] square **(A)** diagonally from upper left to lower right on the lower left corner of **(FF3)**. Sew [1] square **(A)** diagonally from upper right to lower left on the lower right corner of the piece.



10. Sew unit from Step 4 to the left and unit from Step 8 to the right of the unit from Step 9. Section measures 2" x 8-1/2".



Section 4

1. Sew [1] rectangle **(B)** to the top of [1] square **(AA3)**.



2. Sew [1] square **(F)** diagonally from upper left to lower right on the upper right corner of (EE3). Sew [1] square **(F)** diagonally from upper left to lower right on lower left corner. Trim to 1-1/2" x 2".



3. Sew unit from Step 1 to right of unit from Step 2.
4. Sew [1] rectangle **(G)** to the left of unit from Step 3.



5. Sew [1] rectangle **(R)** below the unit from Step 4.



6. Sew [1] square **(P)** diagonally from upper left to lower right on the upper right corner of **(HH3)**. Sew [1] square **(Q)** diagonally from upper left to lower right on the lower left corner. See Figure 9A. Trim to 2-1/2" x 3".

7. Sew [1] **(H)** above the unit from Step 6. See Figure 9B.

- Sew unit from Step 5 to the left of the unit from Step 7.



- Sew [1] rectangle (V) below the unit from Step 8. Section measures 5" x 7".



Section 5

- Sew [1] square (L) diagonally from upper right to lower left on the upper left corner of (GG3). Sew [1] square (M) from upper right to lower left on the lower right corner. See Figure 10A. Trim to 2" x 3".
- Sew [1] rectangle (C) above unit from Step 1. See Figure 10B.

- Sew [1] square (A) to [1] square (AA3).



- Sew [1] square (A) diagonally from upper right to lower left on the upper left corner of (BB3). Sew [1] square (A) diagonally from upper right to lower left corner on the lower right corner.



- Sew together from left to right: Step 3 unit, Step 4 unit, and rectangle (B).



- Sew [1] square (M) below the unit from Step 5.



- Sew unit from Step 2 to the left of the unit from Step 6. See Figure 11A.

- Sew [1] rectangle (U) above unit from Step 7. See Figure 11B. Section measures 3-1/2" x 7".

Carnation Block Assembly

- Sew together Sections 1-3 from top to bottom.



- Sew Section 4 to the left of rectangle (DD3). Sew Section 5 to the right of (DD3).



3. Sew unit of Sections 1-3 above the unit of Section 4/(DD3)/Section 5.



CARDINAL FPP BLOCK



Tips

- Check that the sections measure at the below sizes before using. When printing you should make sure that "Fit to Page" is NOT checked and that it prints Actual Size. Templates are at the end of this pattern.
- Sections of block have already been reversed to use for Foundation Paper Piecing (FPP).
- Starting pieces (A1, B1, for example) will usually be the largest and/or have two sides that are the edges of the section.
- Use the longest side of the cut piece to line up with seam allowance in the case of angles being used.

- If you cut [1] piece at a time there will be some of the cut offs that can be used for future pieces. Make the section in order from A-G to reduce confusion.
- After completing a section, trim the edges along the lines and remove the papers.
- Pressing seams open after sewing sections together will reduce bulk.

Section Unfinished Sizes

- Section A: 4-1/2" × 10-1/2"
- Section B: 2-1/2" × 5"
- Section C: 6-1/2" × 7-1/2"
- Section D: 3-1/2" × 5-1/2"
- Section E: 2-1/2" × 3-1/2"
- Section F: 2" × 2-1/2"
- Section G: 1-1/2" × 3-1/2"
- Section H: only contains Piece (H1)

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:

1. Sew O H Block to the left of the Carnation Block.
2. Sew Cardinal Block to the left of the I O Block.
3. Sew rows from two previous steps together. See graphic on next page.

BORDER ASSEMBLY:

1. Sew on Border 1 sides. Press towards the border.
2. Sew on Border 1 top and bottom. Press towards the border.
3. Repeat steps 4-5 for Borders 2 and 3.

FINISHING:

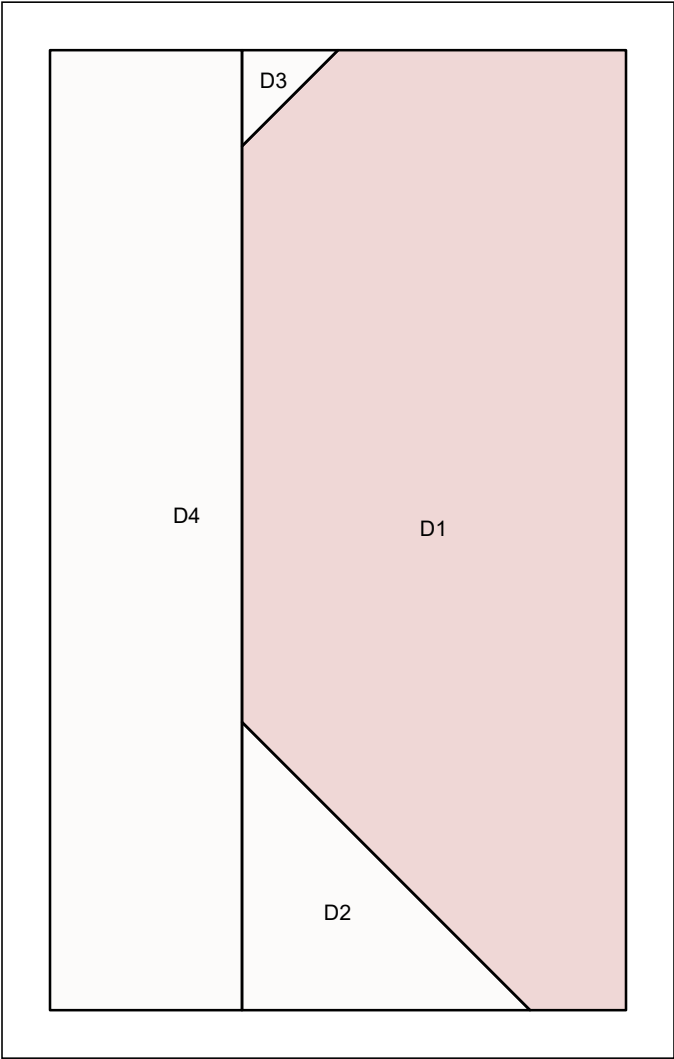
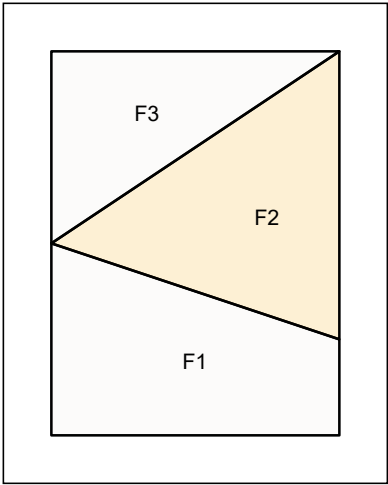
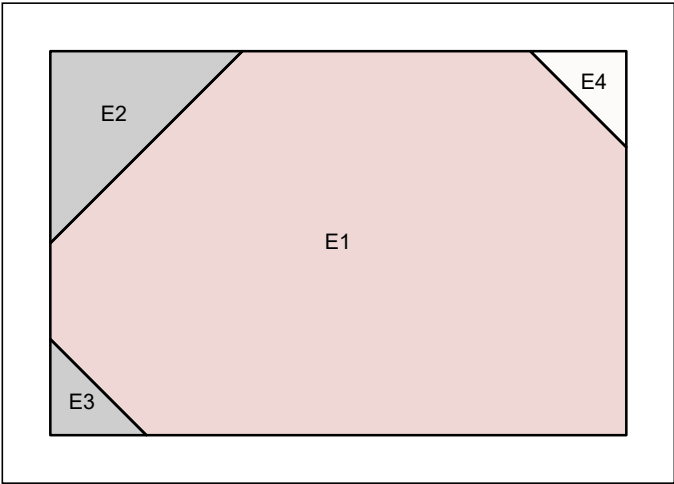
1. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind.
4. Label & Enjoy!

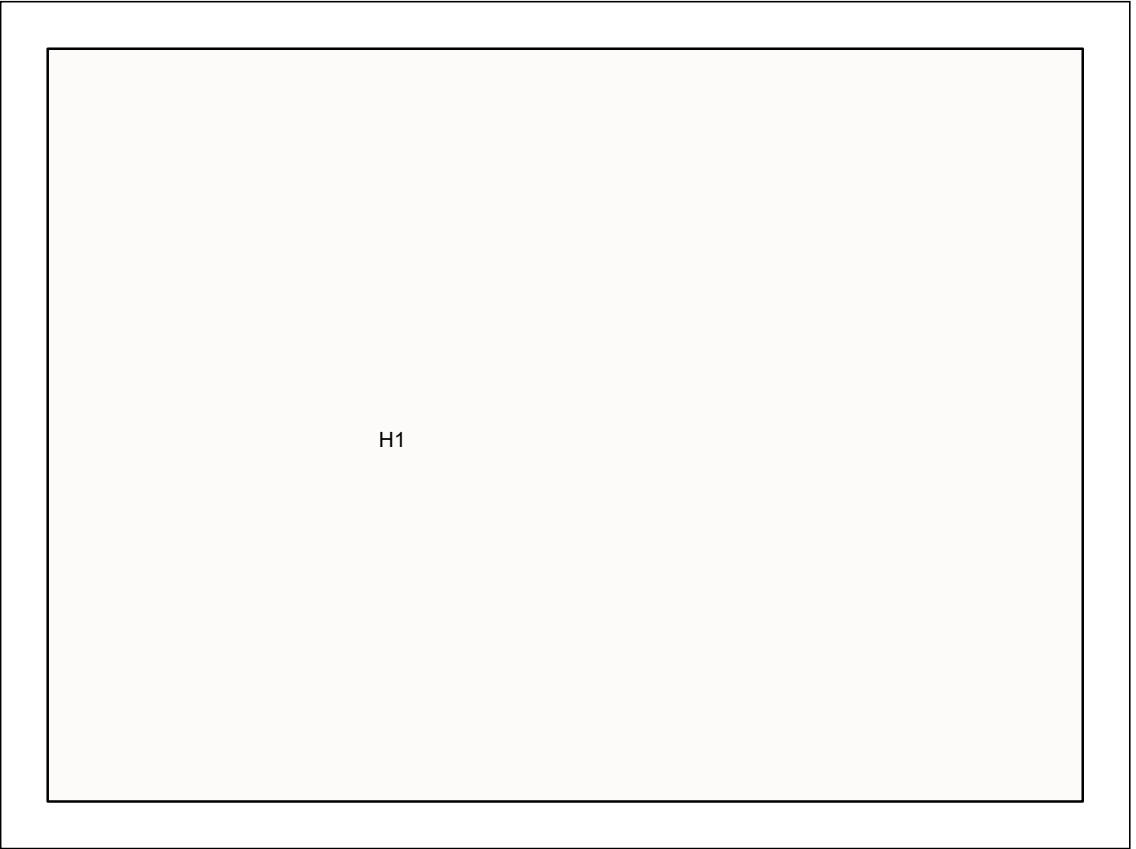
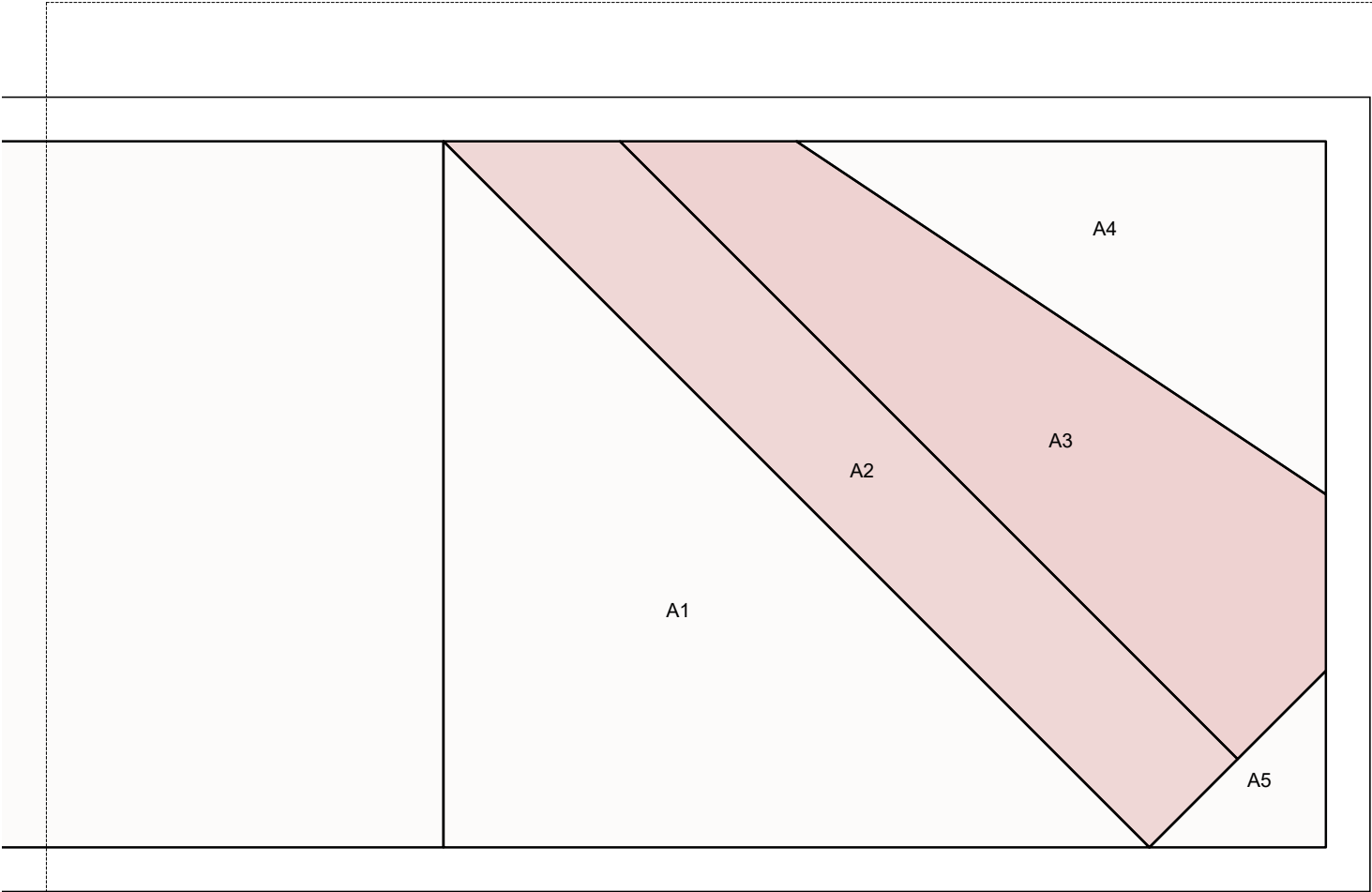


Sarah Guerrero
